Case Study: IMMACULATE HEART HIGH SCHOOL Tucson, Arizona

Loss Event: Microburst - Structural and Water Damage

Damage: Structural and water damage at a private Catholic high school built in

1958.

THE PROBLEM

A sudden microburst brought heavy rain (approximately two inches of rain in 30 minutes) and powerful winds that partially ripped the roof off of the Immaculate Heart High School, a private Catholic School founded in 1930 by the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The microburst caused significant damage to school hallways and 11 classrooms (including science labs). Approximately 50 percent of the 44,000-square-foot facility was affected.

THE SOLUTION

BELFOR quickly mobilized 60-plus workers to extract the water, stabilize the environment and perform emergency services. To minimize the disruption, students and classes were moved to a temporary location while repairs were made to the building.

BELFOR worked closely with the school's insurance carrier, Christian Brothers Services, to determine the scope of the project and establish a mitigation schedule that would meet the needs of the school. The scope of the project included:

- Coordinate temporary relocation of classroom contents (chairs, desks, computers, books, lunch tables, lockers, etc.).
- Set up a modified computer server for administrative and student access.
- Cleaning, packing and temporary storage of school statues and the Madonna, items that are over 100 years old from Spain.
- · Repair and replacement of the roof.
- Renovation and reconstruction of all classrooms, including a new ceiling grid system, lights, whiteboards, drywall and flooring.
- Removal and replacement of asbestos flooring throughout the building.

All repairs were completed in approximately three months. Additional areas of the school not damaged in the storm were also retrofitted with updated light fixtures, ceiling, paint and whiteboards.
